General description:

Purpose of the Role:

The role is offered on a contract basis, linked to specific project completion timeline of approximately 6-8 months with the opportunity to extend onto future projects.

Project sites are based around St Helier.

The post holder will have a good overall understanding of fire protection sprinkler systems and will have the knowledge and skills to be able to carry out a fitment of sprinkler pipe/heads/valves etc to a high standard.

Knowledge of and basic understanding of general construction tasks is preferable.

The Role and Responsibilities are as follows:

Engineer Business Responsibility:

- Successfully install sprinkler system (and pressure test assisted by manager)
- Read schematics and pipe routes from drawings
- Able to read and interpret specifications, product data sheets and health & safety documentation
- Own Tools
- Able to work with basic hand tools and power tools
- To undertake any other tasks as requested from time to time
- Ability to self-risk assess and notify the manager/foreman of any concerns
- Good timekeeping and be reliable

Customer Focus:

- Deliver high quality standards of technical and customer service across our customer base;
- Communicate and engage with customers in a professional and helpful manner at all times;
- Attend and actively engage in customer meetings if and when required;
- Aid the development and growth of the team when opportunities arise, including continuous improvement in quality and customer service delivery.

People Responsibility and Teamwork:

- Be organised and able to work under pressure at times, individually and as part of a team
- Understand the importance to keep a clean and tidy workspace.
- Adept at establishing relationships with all parties involved in the construction process that facilitate harmonious working relationships during tasks and projects.

- Strong communication skills (both with AFM clients and AFM colleagues);

You will be required to provide your own tools to carry out the role (with the exception of specialist equipment required for specific task at the request of AFM). Repairs/replacement of employee tools remain the responsibility of the employee
